Report on the Financial Statements

We have audited the accompanying standalone financial statements of **Assam Medical Service Corporation Limited** ("the company"), which comprise the Balance Sheet as at 31 March 2017, the Statement of Profit and Loss, the Cash Flow Statement for the year then ended on that date, and a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information.

Management's Responsibility for the Financial Statements

This responsibility also includes maintenance of adequate accounting records in accordance with the provisions of the Act for safeguarding the assets of the Company and for preventing and detecting frauds and other irregularities; selection and application of appropriate accounting policies; making judgments and estimates that are reasonable and prudent; and design, implementation and maintenance of adequate internal financial controls, that were operating effectively for ensuring the accuracy and completeness of the accounting records, relevant to the preparation and presentation of the financial statements that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Auditor's Responsibility

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these Standalone financial statements based on our audit.

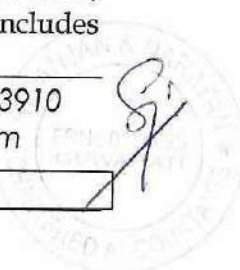
We have taken into account the provisions of the Act, the accounting and auditing standards and matters which are required to be included in the audit report under the provisions of the Act and the Rules made there under.

 - g) With respect to the adequacy of the internal financial controls over financial reporting of the company and the operating effectiveness of such control refer to our separate report in "Annexure B".

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

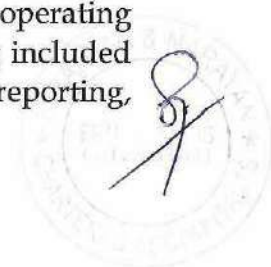
Management's Responsibility for Internal Financial Controls



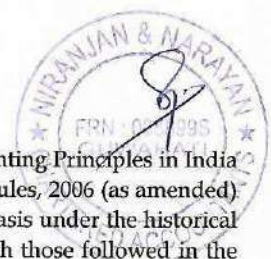
A) Basis for preparation of Financial Statements
